



The Vieira da Silva House-Atelier is open to suggestions for temporary use of the atelier (exhibitions, workshops, conferences, courses, etc.) We accept proposals from individuals and institutions with cultural activities (associations, research institutes, among others).

REGULATIONS FOR TEMPORARY EXIHIBITIONS AT THE VIEIRA DA SILVA HOUSE-ATELIER

The proposal for the temporary exhibition must be submitted by the artist(s) to the Management Board of the Arpad Szenes–Vieira da Silva Foundation (FASVS).

FASVS is not liable for the safety and transport of the exhibits.

Insurance of works and other insurance are the sole responsibility of the artist(s).

No exhibits can be withdrawn or added during the course of the exhibition.

The installation of the temporary exhibitions shall be of the responsibility of FASVS, with the help of the artists. Holes cannot be made in the walls, and all the materials existing in the House must be respected and well preserved.

The Atelier's three wooden easels may or may not be used for the installation of the temporary exhibitions.

The area of the House – on the first floor of the building – cannot be used for the temporary exhibitions.

The following functional areas of the Atelier cannot be blocked during the temporary exhibitions: lavatory, fireplace, central area of the Atelier, windows, wash hand basin near the lavatory, electric panel, fire extinguisher.

Both the opening and finissage must be planned and organized together with FASVS, according to the availability of the team and the Museum and House-Atelier programming schedules.

FASVS is responsible for the communication of the temporary exhibitions, through the following channels: social networks; creation of a digital invitation and of a k-line print of two posters displayed in the Museum and at the door of the House-Atelier.

FASVS appreciates and recommends that the artists to promote their temporary exhibition.

The entrance to the temporary exhibition is free.

Opening hours: The opening hours of the temporary exhibition are the same as those of the Museum's. Within those hours, and upon request at the Reception Desk of the Museum, the doors to the Atelier's will be open to all the visitors by one of the Museum's guards, up to a maximum of 50 at the same time. It is also possible to arrange a time with the artist so that he or she will be present once a week to accompany the visitors.

Temporary exhibitions do not give the right to artistic residence in the House. Artistic residence follows its own rules and is subject to separate applications – with the Public Regulations available for consultation on the FASVS webpage or on the webpage of the House-Atelier.

Temporary exhibitions cannot disturb the House guests therefore the use of any type of sound amplification is not encouraged, except in unusual instances and in coordination with the FASVS team.

Artists in residence at the House can still work at the Atelier during the course of the temporary exhibitions.

The House-Atelier's regular activities and events will continue during the temporary exhibition, always through the coordination between the artists and the FASVS team so that the artists are informed about possible occasional and small changes to the installation of the temporary exhibitions, and so that they be able to follow them should they wish.

Temporary exhibitions cannot last more than two months.

No commercial activity is allowed within the Atelier area in relation to the temporary exhibitions. Exhibits may not be sold in the Atelier during the length of the temporary exhibition. Books and other material for sale in the FASVS shop are allowed – near the Museum Reception – in coordination with the FASVS team.

FASVS does not pay the artist any fee.

The expense of exhibiting in the House-Atelier is 1,000€ + VAT, for production costs, installation and maintenance.

The applicants to the temporary exhibits in the House-Atelier must be aware of the general regulations governing FASVS and the House-Atelier, available on the FASVS and the House-Atelier Webpage.
